VSC AND ABS: DASHBOARD BRAKE LIGHTS

- Picking up from where we left off on last week's tip.
- If the dashboard's VSC and ABS lights come on, you will need to have them looked at immediately as this could indicate a potential safety issue.
- VSC is Vehicle Stability Control. It helps to stabilize the vehicle in emergency maneuvers (such as avoiding an object on the road) and slick road conditions (rain or ice) especially when going around corners.
- ABS is Anti-lock Braking System. It prevents the wheels from locking up (especially during hard braking) in order to avoid uncontrollable skidding.
