WHEN TO PERFORM AN ALIGNMENT

- Your vehicle pulls to one side when you leave the steering wheel while driving. Note that a very slight pull is normal, especially on vehicles with uneven lengths of front drive shafts. This is particularly true in front wheel drives.
- When you get new tires. Not required but check and correct alignment when installing new tires.
- Whenever you perform a tie rod job on your car.
- When you get involved in an accident that affects your front end or your frame.
- When you adjust the height of your vehicle.
- If you have old tires, perform an alignment once a year. Pick a time of the year and consistently perform alignment at that time.
